Summary: Team of teachers viewed all IRIS Strategies and decided on Collaborative Strategic Reading across all curricula. Team developed a presentation using the strategy to train the rest of the faculty. Teachers implemented the strategy in the classrooms. Increased metacognitive conversations, peer collaboration, and shared schoolwide terminology. Fidelity to Collaborative Strategic Reading, Frayer model, and Anticipation/Reaction stratifies was a struggle.
